

**BRANCH I** 2,500-3,500 square feet Library materials: 5,000-15,000 items Population: Up to 6,000 Public Computers, Conference Room, Children & Teen Spaces

**BRANCH II** 6,000-10,000 square feet Library materials: 10,000-25,000 items Population: 6,000 to 12,000 Computer Lab, Community Meeting Room, Children & Teen Spaces

**BRANCH III** 11,000-14,000 square feet Library materials: 25,000-50,000 items Population: 12,000 to 30,000 Computer Lab, Conference Room, Community Meeting Room Children & Teen Spaces

**REGIONAL** 20,000-25,000 square feet Library materials: 50,000-150,000 items Population: 30,000 to 75,000 Computer Lab, Conference Room, Community Meeting Room Children's Room, Teen Space

**CENTRAL** 330,000 square feet Library materials: 2-2.5 million items Population: All County Library Districts Computer Labs, Conference and Study Rooms, Literacy Center History and Genealogy Room, Talking Book Library for the Blind Children's Room, Teen Room, Auditorium, Café
