LIBRARY KICKS OFF SUMMER READING EVENTS FOR YOUTH, ADULTS



Reading is so delicious! The Fresno County Public Library is pleased to announce its annual summer reading program for all ages, this year with a foodinspired theme. All children and teens who read will win a prize. Adults who perform the tasks of their activity "menu" will be entered into weekly drawings for 49 gift baskets. All adults, teens and children who complete the program will be eligible for the grand prize drawing of seven *Kindle Fires*.

Additional summer reading highlighted events from **June 15th to August 4th** include:

- Kickoff event at the San Joaquin River Parkway from 9am-12pm, Saturday June 15th. E&M's Reptile Family and Oklin Bloodworth will be performing; other attractions include games, crafts, bubbles, a bounce house, the Tail Waggin' Tutors, Bentley the Library Dog, food trucks, the Library bookmobile, story times, and summer reading program registration. - All About Yosemite. First, the Library will offer An Evening with John Muir, where an expert will get into character to share secrets of Yosemite, 7pm July 17th at Woodward Park Library. Next, community is invited to join the Library on a bus trip to Yosemite, leaving the Central Library at 8am July 21st.

- Children's programs include: magicians; puppet shows; singing and dancing; drumming and storytelling; a reptile show; and a bubble show.

- In addition to the Yosemite events, a fly fishing series, and square dancing, the following adult authors will speak: James Tyner (Poet Laureate of Fresno); Lillian Faderman (My Mother's Wars) Ken Eaton (Missing Dog Tags); Eric Taylor (Mist); and Chad Stambaugh, (Paranormal Investigations).
