




Sierra Gateway WiFi Users in May-17








Sierra Gateway PC Users in May-17






CIPHER Fresno County Public Library Metrics April 2017












Fresno County Public Library's website is the virtual presentation of our resources and services to the outside world. Libraries are transforming into information centers, learning centers, and training centers. Fresno County Public Library's website serves as a hub for databases, electronic resources and many services.

Last year Fresno county Public library had 3,216,768 visitors to the website, and in this half of the fiscal year 1,430,912 people visited the Library's site. In the month of December we had 70,941 visitors to our website.




Digital Inclusion

Fresno County Public Library provides technology access and training. All members of the community with a library card have equitable access to Internet-connected devices and our online electronic resources. The chart below shows the branches with variety of computer equipment and the number of check-outs for those devices in the month of November.





Pronunciator: In July 2016, Fresno County Public Library added a new language learning database, "Pronunciator" to its electronic resources collection. "Pronunciator" is a fun and free way to learn any of 80 languages with self-directed lessons, live teachers, movies, music and more. It also offers the largest ESL curriculum with courses taught in 51 non-English languages, plus a Citizenship course that is specifically designed for immigrants to successfully pass the Naturalization test.




Pronunciator Top 10 Languages Studied by FCPL Customers



Summer Reading Programs create and sustain a love of reading in children and help to prevent the loss of reading skills over summer.




