DOWNTOWN FRESNO COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY ANNOUNCES EXTERIOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Central Branch of the Fresno County Public Library, located in downtown Fresno, will undergo an upcoming exterior construction project. The initial phase of this project is scheduled to begin on August 19, 2024.

During this period, sections of the building's exterior will undergo significant renovation, including updates to roofing, windows, and electrical outfitting. While we aim to minimize disruptions, the building may need to be closed periodically to the public for safety reasons.
