SELMA PUBLIC LIBRARY TO CLOSE FOR MAJOR REMODEL BEGINNING OCTOBER 19TH

The Selma Public Library is set to undergo a major renovation aimed at modernizing the building and enhancing the library experience for the community.

The Selma Public Library will be open through Friday, October 18th, and will close to the public on Saturday, October 19th, to allow for construction. While the library is eager to begin this transformation, an estimated completion date has not yet been set. Updates on the remodel's progress, including an estimated reopening date, will be provided through the library's website and social media platforms.

Alternate Service Locations

During the remodel, patrons are encouraged to visit nearby branches to continue accessing library services. For those who use the library's "holds" feature, reserved items will automatically be sent to the Fowler Branch Library for pickup. However, patrons may also choose an alternate pickup location through the library's website. To better serve the Selma community during this time, the Fowler Branch has extended its hours to accommodate increased demand and ensure continued convenience for all patrons.
