






Blossom Trail PC Users in May-17






Park View WiFi Users in May-17




Park View PC Users in May-17






Sierra Gateway WiFi Users in May-17




Sierra Gateway PC Users in May-17




In April 2017, a total of **229,518** people visited Fresno County Public library branches and **246,712** people visited the Library's website (www.fresnolibrary.org).

















Ancestry FY 2016-2017














FCPL Website Visitors from Different States in December 2016

FCPL World Visitors








Pronunciator: In July 2016, Fresno County Public Library added a new language learning database, “Pronunciator” to its electronic resources collection. “Pronunciator” is a fun and free way to learn any of 80 languages with self-directed lessons, live teachers, movies, music and more. It also offers the largest ESL curriculum with courses taught in 51 non-English languages, plus a Citizenship course that is specifically designed for immigrants to successfully pass the Naturalization test.

◆ Total Registrations ■ Total Logins ▲ ProCitizen Logins (Citizenship)








Summer Reading Programs create and sustain a love of reading in children and help to prevent the loss of reading skills over summer.


Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Circulation by Cluster




